

# VA Advanced Fellowship Health Systems Research For Physicians - Denver, CO

### **OVERVIEW**

The Denver/Seattle Center of Innovation (COIN) for Veteran-Centered and Value-Driven Care, located in Denver, Colorado, is seeking enthusiastic and innovative physician applicants for a Postdoctoral Fellowship in Health Systems Research (HSR).

The two-year HSR Fellowship Program provides research training to physician researchers who have interest areas that position them to improve Veterans health. The Fellowship works closely with AcademyHealth as a national coordinating center to provide high-quality training and curriculum focused on Learning Health Systems core competencies.

The HSR Fellowship emphasizes education, research, and mentorship. Physician Fellows devote 75% of their time to health systems research, and/or education activities, and spend the remaining 25% providing clinical care.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Completion of a residency program
   accredited by the Accreditation Council for
   Graduate medical Education (ACGME) or
   the Bureau of Professional Education (BPE) of
   the American Osteopathic Association.
- Not be enrolled simultaneously in any other accredited physician residency or Fellowship Program (waiver required for this)
- Be appropriately board certified or eligible.
- Be a U.S. citizen.

#### **COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS**

- The fellowship includes a competitive salary with federal employee health benefits.
- Salary is commensurate to experience and is similar to NIH (scientists) and postgraduate year (clinician) scales.
- Personal workspace with access to COIN.

## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

- The application process requires a CV, cover letter, letters of recommendation and a proposed research project.
