The two-year HSR Fellowship Program provides PhD researchers the training and support to apply their research In the VA and complete publishable research projects.

The Denver COIN seeks both clinical and non-clinical PhD level researchers who have interest areas that position them to impact and improve Veterans' Health. The HSR Fellowship emphasizes education, research, and mentorship, and allows Fellows to hone skills in a variety of areas.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Demonstrate interest in pursuina a VA career with health systems research and healthcare improvement as part of a Learning Health System.
- Not be simultaneously enrolled in an accredited clinical training program.

CLINICALLY TRAINED PHD

- Be a fully credentialed independent practitioner e.g., nurse, psychologist, physical therapist
- Hold an active unrestricted license to practice in the U.S.

NON-CLINICAL PHD

- Possess a doctoral degree from an accredited educational institution.
- Meet all eligibility criteria for hire within a VA facility.
- Have a stated pursuit in the fields of health systems research and healthcare improvement.

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

- The fellowship includes a competitive salary with federal employee health benefits.
- Salary is commensurate to experience and is similar to NIH (scientists) and postgraduate year (clinician) scales.
- Personal workspace with access to COIN resources will be provided.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The application process requires a CV, cover letter, letters of recommendation and a proposed research project.
