The two-year HSR Fellowship Program provides novice PhD researchers the training and support to apply their research and complete publishable research projects.

The Denver COIN seeks both clinical and non-clinical PhD level researchers who have interest areas that critically position them to impact and improve Veterans' Health. The HSR Fellowship emphasizes education, research, and mentorship, and allows Fellows to hone skills in a variety of areas.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Demonstrate interest in pursuing a VA career with health services research and healthcare improvement as part of a Learning Health System.
- Not be simultaneously enrolled in an accredited clinical training program.
- Meets COVID Vaccination Requirements

ASSOCIATED HEALTH FELLOWS

- Be a fully credentialed independent practitioner (Nurse, Clinical or Counseling Psychology-Associated Health Fellows).
- Hold an active unrestricted license to practice in the U.S.

NON-CLINICAL PHD

- Possess a doctoral degree from an accredited educational institution.
- Meet all eligibility criteria for hire within a VA facility.
- Have a stated pursuit in the fields of health services research and healthcare improvement.

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

- The stipend rate for Fellows will be determined by the Office of Academic Affiliation. Fellows shall not receive additional revenue for their duties during this program.
- Fellows receive health insurance and vacation benefits.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Interest – desire to conduct Health services research in rapidly changing health care settings and demonstrate interest in the focus of research at the Denver COIN.
- Potential – likelihood to succeed in a career incorporating health services research for Veterans.
- Match – with available mentors at Denver COIN/University of Colorado - Anschutz Medical Campus.
