Did You Know?

When you are discharged from the hospital setting, information needs to be passed on to your Primary care provider (PCP) at home.

Living in rural areas sometimes makes it more difficult to coordinate follow up needs from your hospital admission.



The Transitions Nurse can help you have a safer transition back into your home clinic.

Your Transitions Nurse is here to assist you with the following:

- 1.** Helping you understand your discharge information and medications.
- 2.** Coordinating a follow up appointment with your PCP after discharge and sending information about your hospital stay to PCP.
- 3.** Calling you after you transition home, for a follow up call.
